Today on 26-11-2019, Jammu: J&K Wildlife Protection Department celebrated “Constitution Day” of India in remembrance of adoption of Constitution of India by the Parliament on 26th November, 1949.

The 70th Anniversary of the “Constitution Day” was presided over by Sh. Suresh K. Gupta, Chief Wildlife Warden, J&K. More than hundred employees of the wildlife protection department along with Regional, district and headquarter Wildlife Wardens took part in the celebration.

During the celebration, Sh. S K Gupta highlighted the significance of the constitution, which, not only guarantees liberty, justice, and equality to one and all but also build fraternity among its citizens’ while mandating certain fundamental duties to be performed by every citizen.
