The meeting started with the brief background of the Agenda Item No. 2, Proposal for rationalization of boundaries of Sudhmahdev Wildlife Conservation Reserve by the Member Secretary and it was followed by discussion and the proposal was agreed to with a suggestion to revisit the area to explore the possibility of inclusion of some compartments of Marmat Range of Batote Forest Division in lieu of some of the compartments proposed to be added to the Conservation Reserve, which appeared close to habitation on the map, to avoid any future interference. In the event it is not possible on revisit to modify the above proposal; it shall stand approved and be forwarded to the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife for its consideration.
