It has been noticed that research programmes in Wildlife Department are not being monitored properly and in many cases concerned Wildlife Wardens are not aware of such research studies and projects. The research studies need to be conducted in a well-organized manner under proper monitoring.

Therefore it is enjoined upon all the Wildlife Wardens to examine all such research proposals thoroughly before submitting for permission to Regional Wildlife Wardens with comments and recommendations.

The Research Officer is directed to prepare a list of all the research work conducted till date in the state and submit a copy of the same within a period of two weeks to the undersigned with a copy to all Regional Wildlife Wardens.

The concerned Wildlife Warden will be one of the co-investigators and the concerned Regional Wildlife Warden will be the co-supervisors of any such research project to be taken up in a PA under their jurisdictions.

The Concerned Wildlife Warden will maintain attendance register of the researcher and review the progress on monthly basis.

Before any research project is put up before Chief Wildlife Warden J&K, for approval it should invariably have comments from the concerned Regional Wildlife Warden.

The instruction be strictly adhered to.
